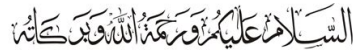




## JAMI OMAR REOPENING PHASE 3 REV.1



Effective start date: Tuesday, Feb 16th 2021

This guideline is for Phase 3 rev. 1. Please adhere to the Ministry Of Health Ontario, Ottawa Public Health guidelines in general and the following guidelines while at the Masjid.

### SALAAT GUIDELINES

- ❖ The guideline is for all salaah
- ❖ **Who can not attend**
  - Anybody sick or with compromised immunity or existing health concerns must not attend salaah.
  - Youths 9 yrs age and under must not attend the salaah.
- ❖ The minor should always be accompanied by a parent / guardian
- ❖ We highly recommend that the elders (above the age of 65) to pray at home.
- ❖ **Mandatory registration for daily salaah**
  - Online at [www.jamiomar.org](http://www.jamiomar.org) for those salaah that you would most certainly attend.
  - With administration at (613) 828-2222 – if you do not have access to internet.
  - Bring your registration copy (in-app, email or paper form) to the Masjid.
  - Your registration is non transferrable to any other person.
  - Each attendee must enter their name for registration pass.
  - The registration is only meant for Salaah and not meant for Nikaah, Janaza, Qur'an khwani.
- ❖ Wudu and washroom facilities are unavailable, please come prepared with wudu.
- ❖ **While in the Masjid**
  - Attendees are always required to wear a face mask.
  - Minimize contact in the Masjid.
  - Maintain a physical distance of 2 meters (6 ft) during the salaah and all other times.
- ❖ Sanitize your hands as you come to the Masjid and leave the Masjid
- ❖ Enter and leave the Masjid by keeping a safe distance.
- ❖ If the prayer halls are filled up to the permitted limit by the Ottawa Public Health guideline then the Masjid doors will be closed.
- ❖ Nobody is permitted to pray right outside the Masjid.
- ❖ Do not socialize nor crowd in the Masjid and in the parking lot.
